Members of the Woman's Club of Fullerton reviewed the Legislative Action Center message from GFWC to help prevent online sexual exploitation of children. Members responded to the call of action and sent their notice of support against online sexual exploitation of children to their Senators and Representatives.

Online platforms have fueled the extreme and unprecedented proliferation of child sexual abuse material. Law enforcement has repeatedly warned that children are groomed, enticed, exploited, trafficked, and abused online through platforms we use every day. This has only increased during the Covid-19 years.

Millions of child sexual abuse material are made to the Cyber Tip line hosted by the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children (NCMEC), the nation's clearing house and comprehensive reporting center for all issues related to the preventions of and recovery from child victimization. Technology companies have photo DNA Technology but have not been held accountable for their platforms. This legislation provides a pathway forward.

Advocates believe that removing technology companies' immunity from civil and criminal liability or third party content on their platforms will result in a dramatic decrease in online child sexual abuse materials. Stop Online Child Sexual Exploitation. These Bills supports victims and increases accountability and transparency.
